Indiana Michigan Power (I&M) representatives plan to strengthen the electric transmission system in eastern Indiana. The proposed improvements in Adams County involve rebuilding about 10.5 miles of power line. The project involves rebuilding some sections of line in the company's current right-of-way. Other sections of the project may include re-routes and require new easements. These improvements would increase reliability, reduce power outages and speed recovery of service when outages occur.

WHAT

The project involves rebuilding about 10.5 miles of 69-kilovolt line.

Sections that travel through the town of Monroe include re-routes.

WHY

Improvements:

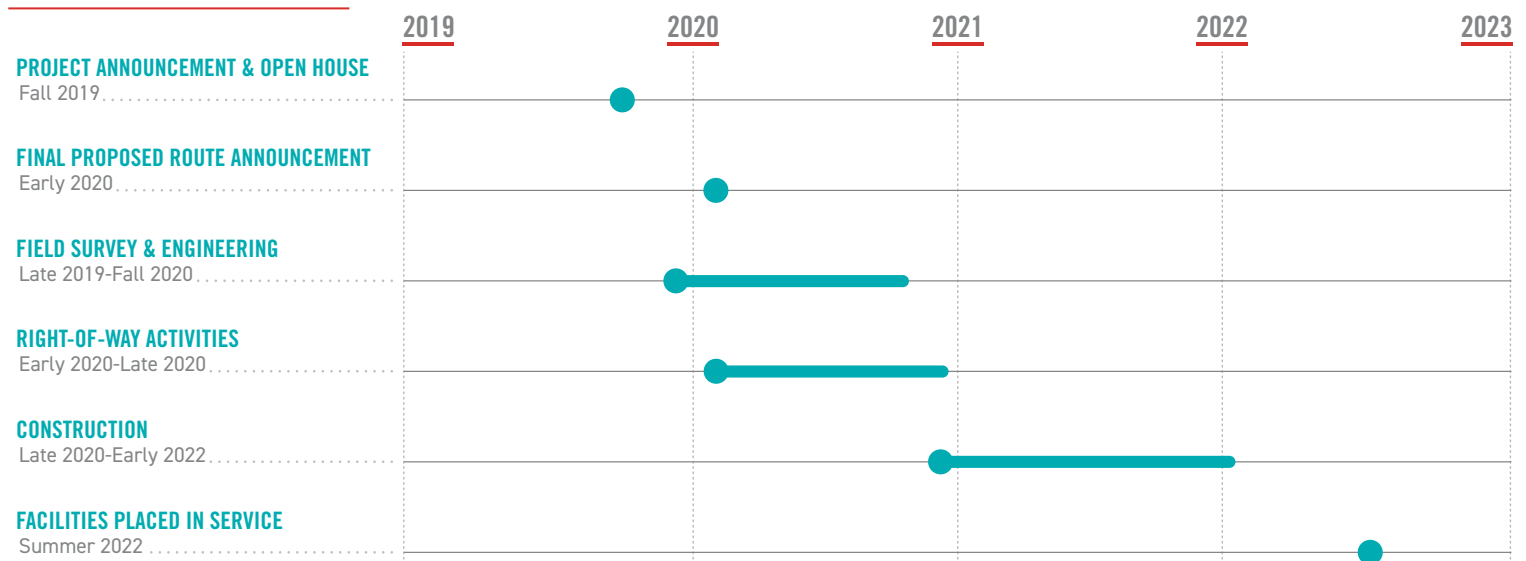
- Strengthens the local electric transmission system

WHERE

The upgrades take place in Washington, and Monroe townships in Adams County.

The project involves replacing aging wooden poles with steel poles.

Structure Height: **70-95 feet***

Right-of-Way Width: **60 feet***
