

# NORTHERN ST. JOSEPH COUNTY AREA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Indiana Michigan Power officials plan power grid improvements for customers in northern Indiana. The Northern St. Joseph County Area Improvements Project involves building about 3 miles of electric transmission line and building a substation.

## WHAT

The project involves:

- Building approximately 3 miles of 138-kilovolt transmission line
- Building a substation off Adams Road

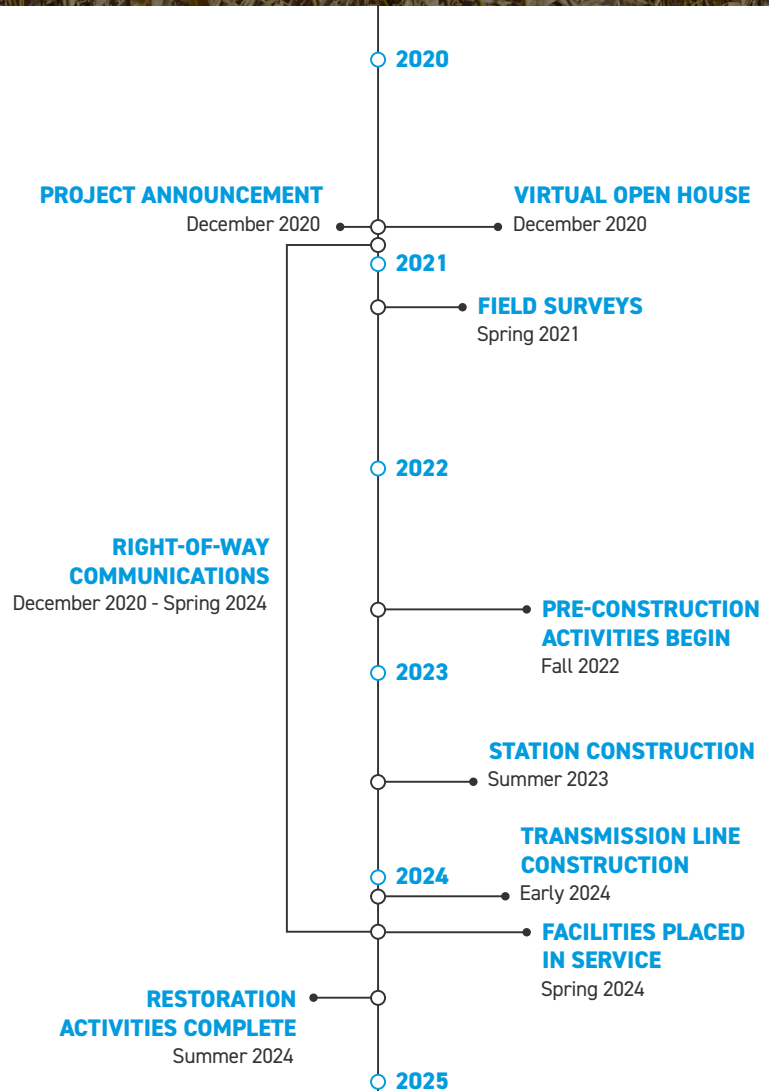
## WHY

The existing electrical network in this area has reached its capacity. The new power line and substation provide an additional power source to ensure reliable electric service for residential and business customers and support economic development in the area.

The project area includes:

- City of South Bend
- German and Warren townships in St. Joseph County



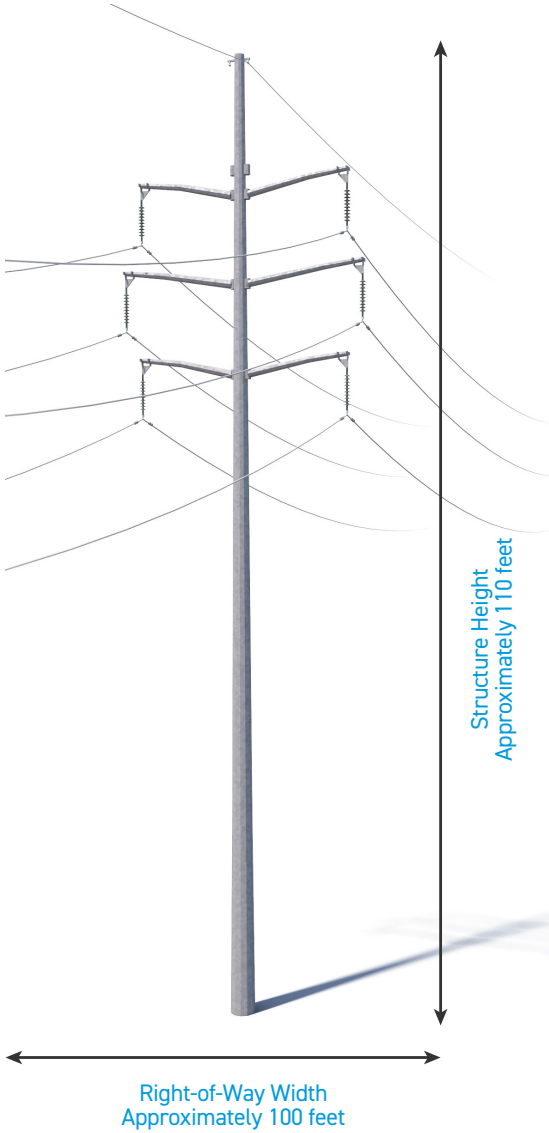

# TYPICAL STRUCTURES

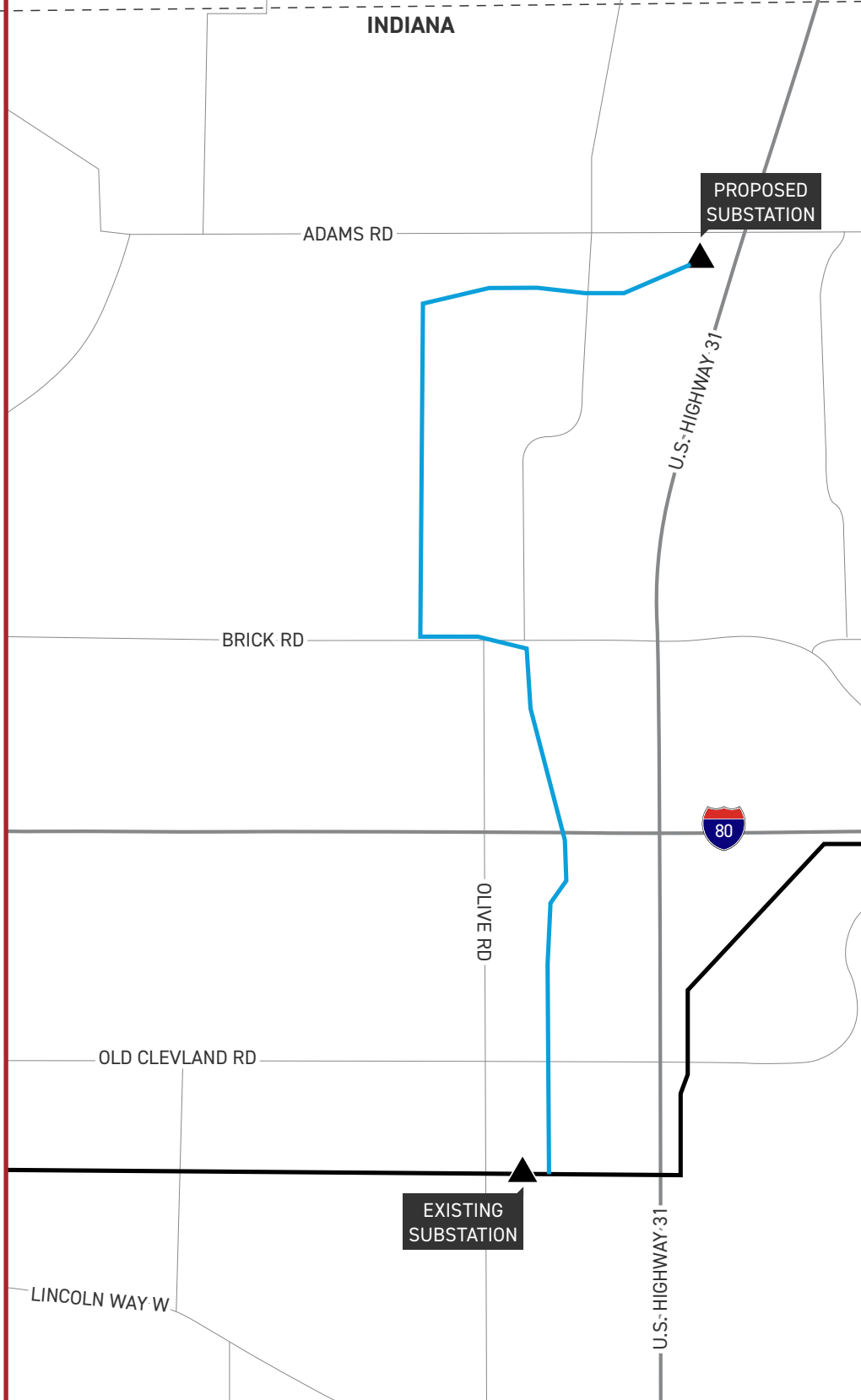
This project involves installing steel poles.
