
NOTICE OF PROPOSED ELECTRICAL UPGRADES

AEP Ohio Announces Temporary Transmission Line Project in Carroll County

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build less than .2 miles of temporary 138-kilovolt (kV) power line extending from the Windsor-Canton 138-kV transmission line to a customer's delivery point. Company officials need to build the transmission line following a customer's request and to provide power to their facility.

AEP Ohio representatives filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as Blackbird Temporary 138kV Extension Project, Case No. 25-0872-EL-BLN. If approved, construction is expected to begin in late 2025 and concludes early 2027. The temporary line is expected to remain in place for more than one year. The improvements support AEP Ohio's



ongoing efforts to enhance electric service reliability and future energy needs in the region.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
