



WHAT

The project involves:


- Building a 345-kilovolt (kV) Celtic Station on company property located near the intersection of Mitchell-Dewitt Road and Warner Road.
- · Connecting Celtic Station to the transmission grid.
- · Filings with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB).

WHY

The new station provides an additional electric source to customer facilities and helps meet the area's growing electrical load demand.

WHERE


The project is located near the intersection of Mitchell-Dewitt Road and Warner Road in Jerome Township, Union County.
