AEP Ohio representatives plan to build an underground electric transmission line south of Interstate 70 in downtown Columbus. The project is necessary to accommodate road improvements by the Ohio Department of Transportation and address aging infrastructure.



WHAT

The project involves:

- Building approximately 3 miles of underground 138-kilovolt electric transmission line
- Upgrading two substations
- Retiring approximately 4 miles of underground transmission line

*This project requires Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) approval

WHY

The improvements:

- Accommodate road improvements by the Ohio Department of Transportation
- Address aging infrastructure

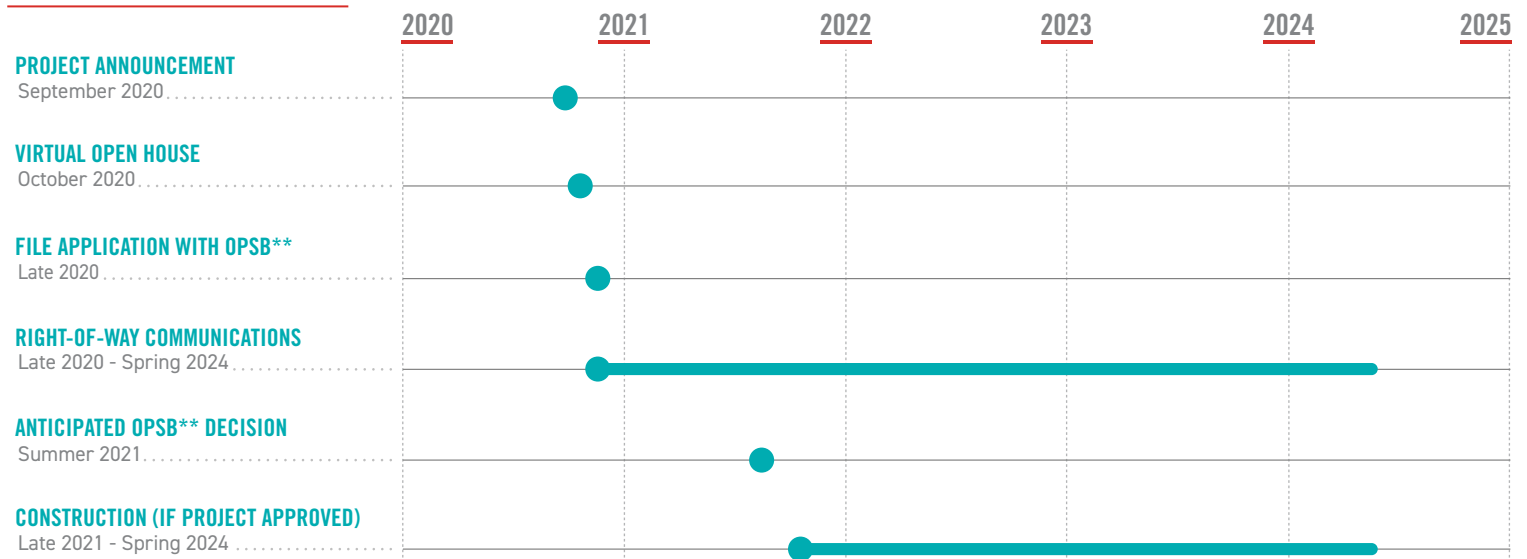
WHERE

- City of Columbus

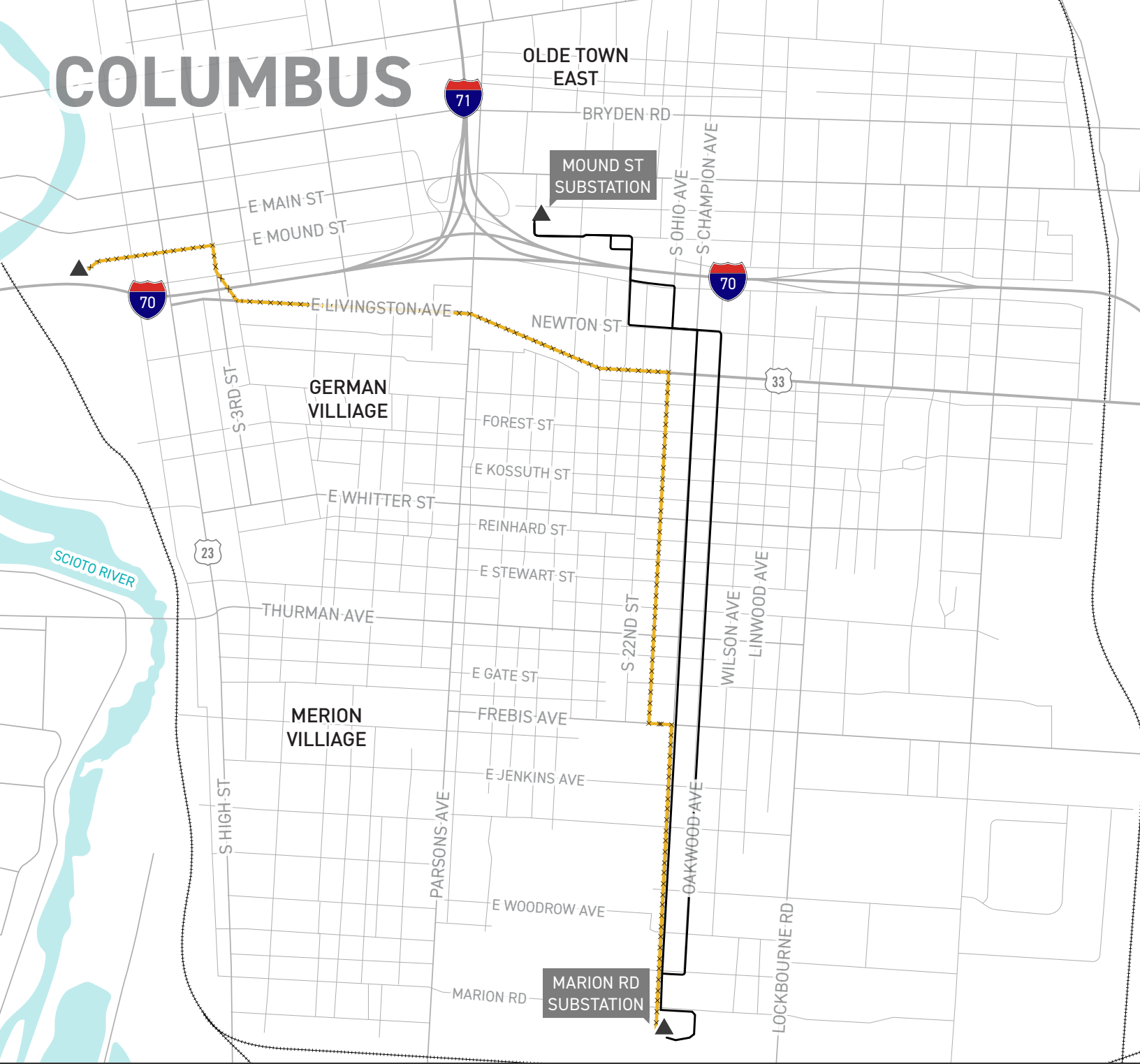


PROJECT SCHEDULE
