

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio and AEP Ohio Transmission Co., Inc., are announcing the Anguin-Babbitt Transmission Line Project as part of planned improvements to strengthen the local power grid and support economic growth in the New Albany Area. The project involves building about 1.6 miles of 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line between the Babbitt Substation and proposed Anguin Substation. Plans also include building an additional .4 miles of 138-kV transmission line as an extension from the Anguin Substation to a customer facility.

Construction begins this summer.

AEP Ohio Transco filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Anguin-Babbitt 138-kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 19-0266-EL-BLN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the OPSB.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are available in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
