

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio has proposed minor changes to an upcoming electric transmission project in Jackson County, Ohio. The company announced the North Jackson 138-kV Transmission Line Project in May 2018 and filed the project with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Heppner Switch-Lick 138-kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 17-0808-EL-BLN. The approved project involves constructing approximately 4 miles of 69-kilovolt (kV) transmission line to 138-kV power line between Heppner Switch Station and Lick Substation. The project is located on the northeast side of the City of Jackson.

As the project continues to develop, AEP Ohio has recommended minor adjustments to the approved power line route.

AEP Ohio Transmission Co., Inc., a subsidiary of AEP Ohio, filed the updated route with the OPSB as the Adjustment to Heppner Switch-Lick 138-kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 19-1487-EL-BLN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits review by the OPSB.

The project supports economic development and improves electric reliability in the area. The company began construction on this project in January and plans to continue work on the adjusted sections of the power line route if it receives approval from the OPSB.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are available in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. 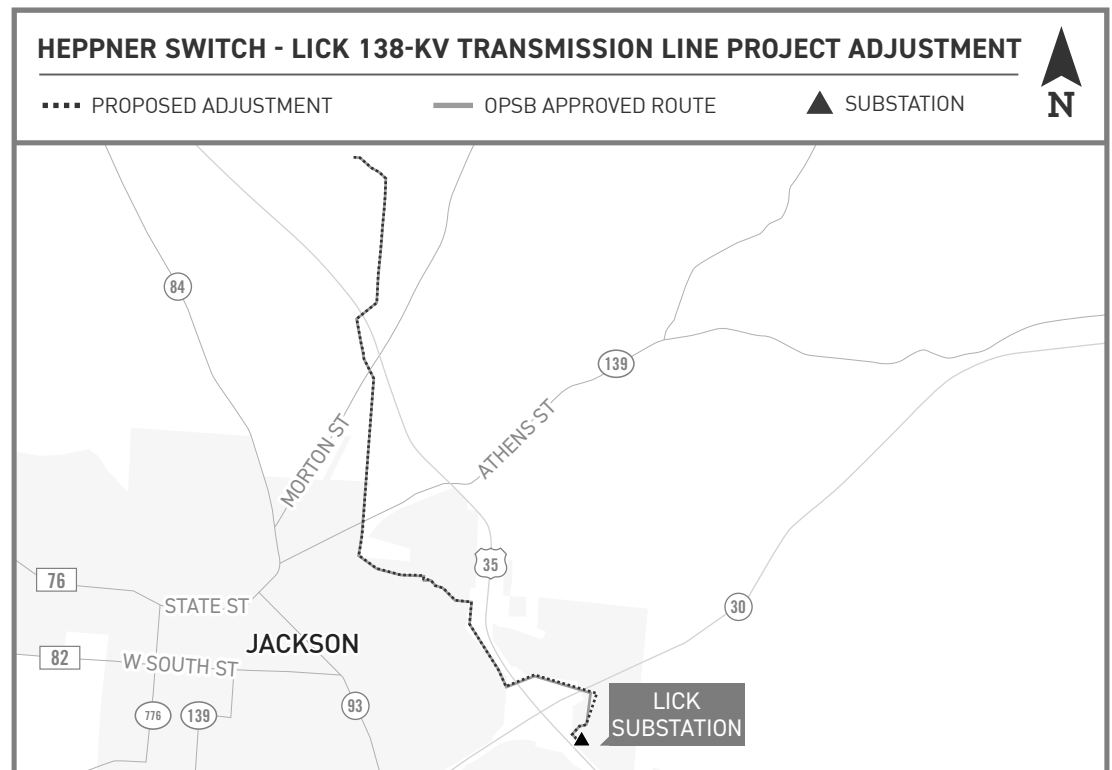
