

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., (AEP Ohio Transco) proposes to relocate a 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line in York and Waterloo townships in Athens County.

The purpose of the Lemaster-Lick 138-kV Transmission Line Relocation Project is to relocate an existing 138 kV transmission line on property owned by AEP Ohio Transco. This project will help improve and maintain the electric service reliability in Athens County and the surrounding area. AEP Ohio Transco will build the new line using standard single-pole, steel structures. The Lemaster-Lick transmission line relocation will be about less than a half mile long. This project will be an approximate \$1 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2017.

The project is known as the Lemaster-Lick 138kV Transmission Line Relocation Project. AEP Ohio Transco has filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 17-0633-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the board.

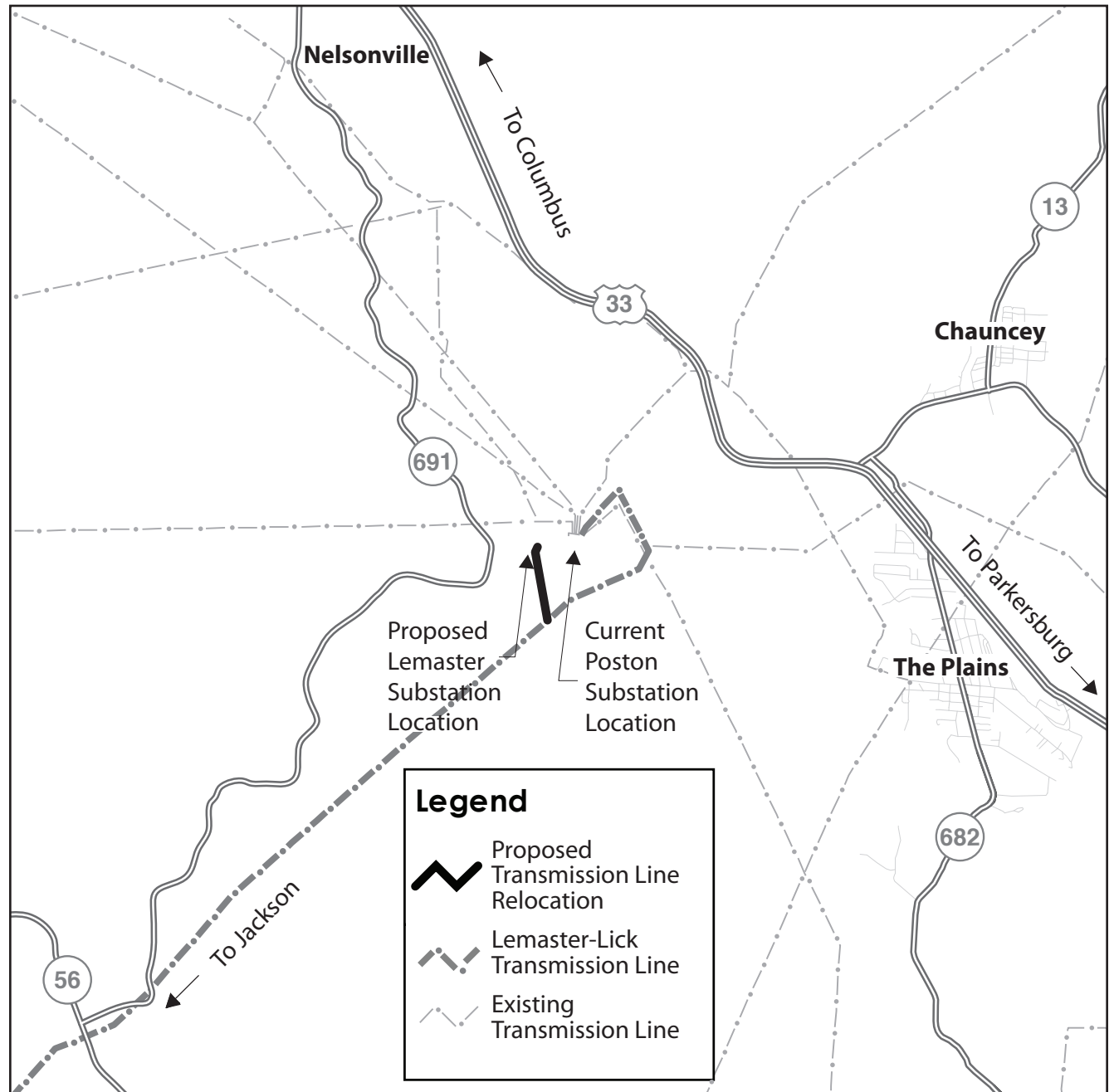
Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the siting board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code. Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 17-0633-EL-BLN.

The accompanying map depicts the project area. It should be noted that due to the reduced scale and limited detail, this map should be used only as a general guide.
