

# NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Transmission Company, Inc., (AEP Ohio Transco), an affiliate of AEP Ohio, proposes to rebuild a 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Pee Pee and Pebble townships in Pike County.

The purpose of the Waverly-Ware Road 138-kV Transmission Line Project is to improve electric service reliability in Pike County. The project involves replacing aging wood structures with modern steel structures and expanding the right-of-way to 100-feet. This project will be an approximate \$13 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in March.

The project is known as the Waverly-Ware Road 138-kV Transmission Line Project. AEP Ohio Transco filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 17-0172-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this transmission line is pending before the board.

Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the siting board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code. Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 17-0172-EL-BLN.

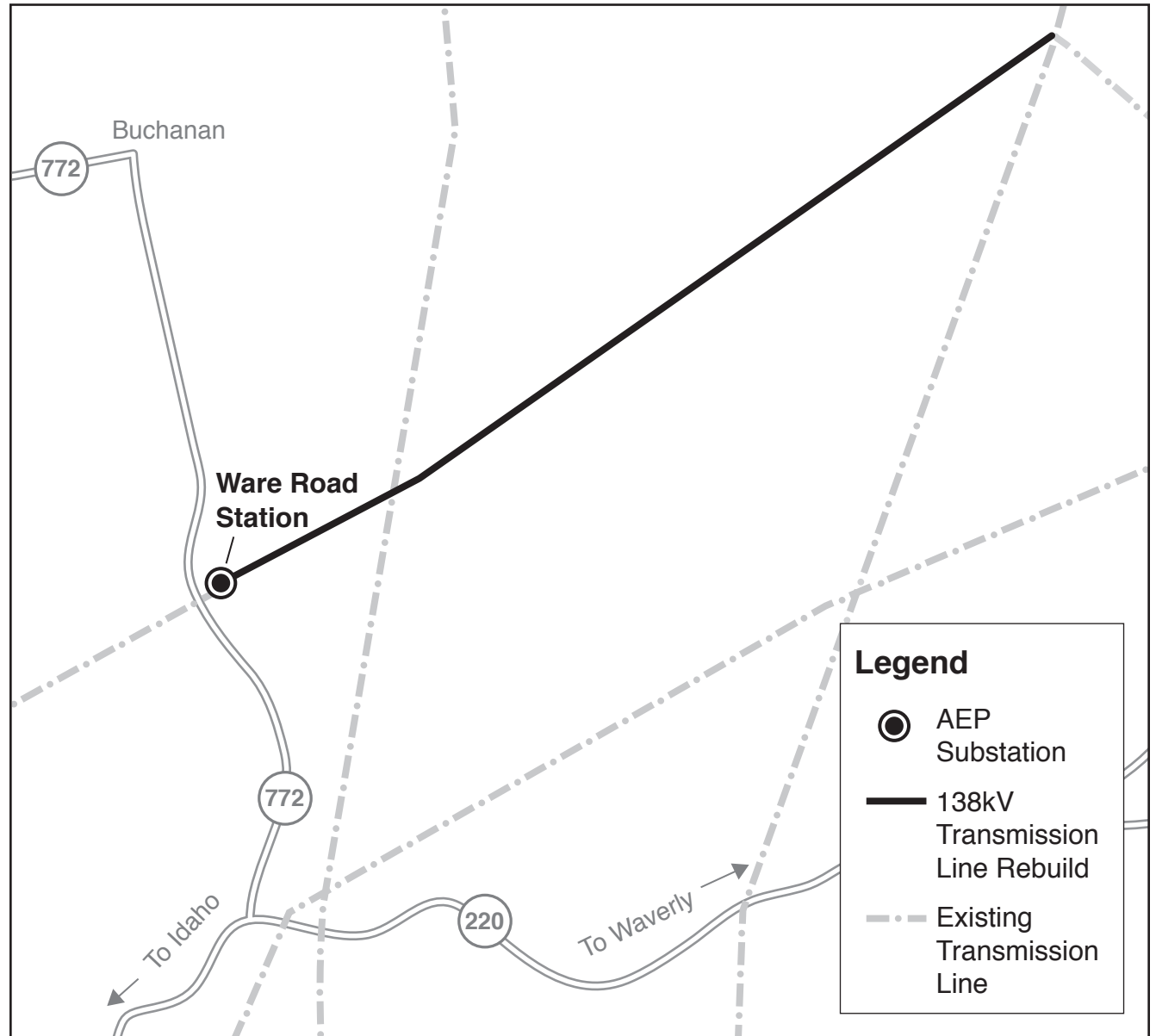
