

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

The Windsor Extension (OH) 138-kV Transmission Line Project

AEP Ohio representatives plan transmission line upgrades to improve electric reliability for customers in Jefferson County, Ohio.

The Tiltonsville-Windsor 138-kV Transmission Line Project includes:

- Replacing about half a mile of power line on existing structures near Tiltonsville, Ohio
- Adding about 4.5 miles of power line parallel to existing wires on structures between Tiltonsville, Ohio, and Windsor Heights, West Virginia
- Adding five structures between Tiltonsville, Ohio and Windsor Heights, West Virginia

As the project continues to develop, AEP Ohio representatives plan to rebuild .4 miles of power line through Warren Township, Jefferson County to the Ohio River north of Rayland. The 100-year-old towers cannot handle the larger conductor needed to meet the area's growing demand. Construction on this section of the power line begins this fall and concludes spring 2022.

AEP Ohio representatives filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Windsor Extension (OH) 138-kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 21-0173-EL-BLN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits review by the OPSB.

Company representatives filed a Letter of Notification for a separate component of the project with the OPSB as the Windsor Junction-Tiltonsville 138 kV Conductor Project, Case No. 20-1735-EL-BLN in December.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene can be found in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and cite Case No. 21-0173-EL-BLN. The accompanying map shows the project area. Please use this map only as a general guide due to its reduced scale and limited detail. 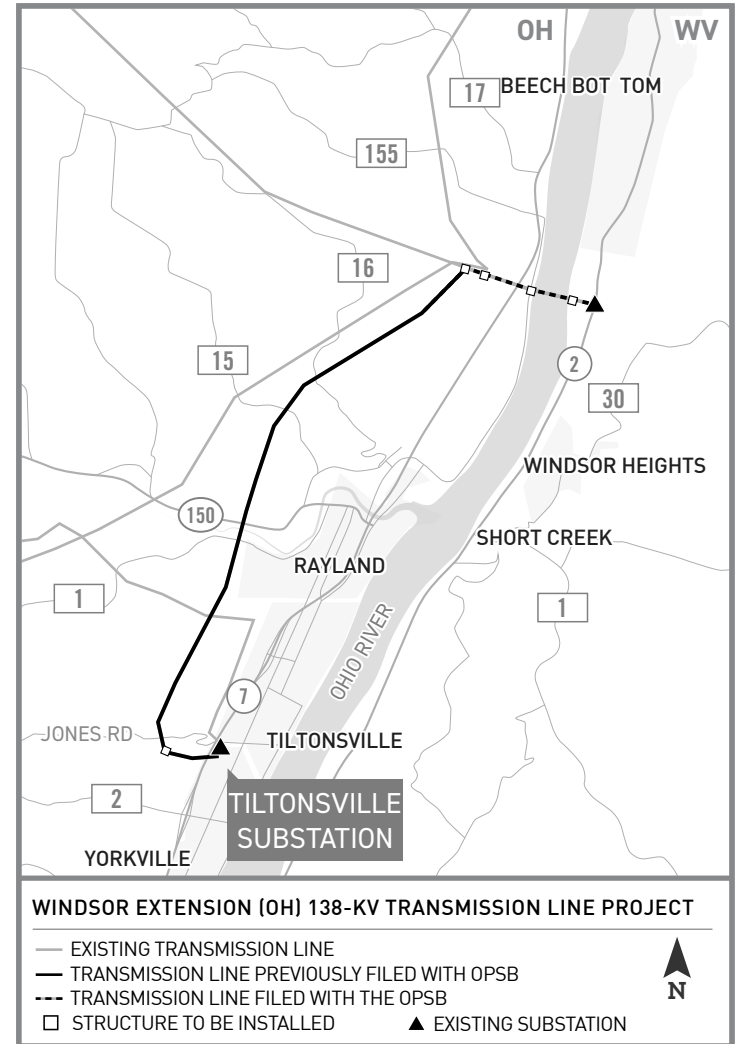
