



## **WHAT**

The Mineola - North Mineola Transmission Improvements Project involves rebuilding approximately 2 miles of 69-kilovolt (kV) transmission line.

The project also involves replacing about a mile of power lines.


## **WHY**

The Mineola - North Mineola transmission line is nearly 75 years old and is past its planned service life. The project:

- · Replaces deteriorating wooden poles with modern steel poles
- Replaces aging wires on a section that was previously rebuilt using concrete poles
- Strengthens the system against severe weather, and decreases the likelihood and duration of wide, community-sustained outages

## WHERE

The line stretches between the Mineola Substation, located at West Front Street and South Street, and North Mineola Substation, located near the intersection of Northeast Loop 564 and FM 1254.
